Session 1 Monday, June 21—Friday, June 25 9 am to noon

5 to 6 year olds Course June 1—A
ART THAT MOVES

with teaching artist *Danielle Perriera*
Create 3-D art inspired by Chinese shadow puppets. Have fun drawing and making shapes of your characters! Give your art personality and bring a story alive!

AMAZING COLLAGED CREATURES

with teaching artist *Susan Connors*
Work with cut and torn paper to create imaginative creatures in collage. Create exciting, original, out of this world art!

7 to 8 year olds Course June 1—B
STILL LIFE DRAWING

with teaching artist *Brian Williams*
Use observational skills to draw what you see. Emphasis will be on creating depth, contrast and volume. It's all about bringing tints and shades into your artwork.

Work out an original, action story. Create 3-D art inspired by puppets from around the world. Have fun combining moving shapes to tell your story!

Create sculpture that's flat on the back! Use a variety of materials: paper, cardboard, wood, straw, string and yarn. Creativity will inspire your work!

PRIMITIVE ANIMAL FORMS

with teaching artist *Susan Connors*
Create with unusual and nontraditional materials in paint. Use expressive outline and form to create common animals with a thick surface for inventive designs and symbols.

MAKING YOUR MARK

with teaching artist *Danielle Perriera*
Expand your drawing skills. Work in non-objective style to create imaginative abstract drawings with colored pencils. It's all about shading and space!

WHAT? A RELIEF!

Create low and high relief sculptures. Incorporate a variety of materials: foam core, wood, plaster and clay. Inspire creativity in your 3-D art forms!

Explore planes of the face using pencil, pen, brush and ink, charcoal and the eraser as a tool. Go from a cubist sketch to the curves and sculptural image of the head.
