Session 1 TEEN-1

JUNE 21 through 25
COLLAGE/MIXED MEDIA:
ART OF THE BOOK

with Meryl Perloff and Sue McKee
One-of-a-kind free form books! At a relaxed pace, teens will create unusual shaped books of their own design using collage and mixed media explorations as creative personal expressions.

Meryl Perloff, with a degree in art from University of Wisconsin, Madison, has pursued a lifelong career in interior design and studio art. Her current focus is a multi media approach to Book Arts. **Sue McKee**, adds her design and watercolor talents to this class. Sue has studied in the US and Europe and has her art selected for many juried exhibitions.

Session 4 TEEN-4

JULY 19 through 23
OBSERVATIONAL DRAWING

with teaching artist Nixson Borah
Emphasize your capacity to create expressive and accurate drawings. Focus will be on learning contour and perspective drawing using the figure and environment as subject matter. Both black, white and color art materials will be used.

Nixson Borah, professor emeritus from Fullerton College in Orange County, has exhibited in numerous galleries and museums and is included in private collections on both coasts. His wide range of expertise includes drawing, painting, printmaking, sculpture and photography.

Session 2 TEEN-2

JUNE 28 through JULY 2
SKETCH WALKS

with teaching artist Janine Kirkpatrick
Walk to nearby gardens, street scenes and creek walks—all within a block of the museum. Develop your sketchbook to record your artistic observations.

Janine Kirkpatrick studied art at Kean University in New Jersey, Haystack Mountain School of Crafts in Maine, and Brooklyn Museum Art School in New York. Her current project is drawing California's rare and endangered butterflies, with their host plants.

Session 5 TEEN-5

AUGUST 2 through 6
PAINTING EXPLORATION

with teaching artist Deborah Veldkamp
Find your unique talent for expressing ideas in painting. Explore a broad use of acrylic paints on canvas and paper. One session will focus on composition with a human figure. Your individual creativity is encouraged in this class.

Deborah Veldkamp, a landscape, portrait and figure painter, began her studies with classical painter Peter Blos in the San Francisco area. She continued her studies at the Art Center College of Design in Los Angeles, California College of Arts and Crafts in Oakland, and at Long Beach State University. She has exhibited widely on the West Coast and Europe.

WATERCOLOR IN DEPTH

with teaching artist Marianne Nucci

Session 6 TEEN-6

with teaching artist Julie Steyer
Explore the symbols of the box. Identify themes and ideas included in an inside/outside box in the style of Joseph Cornell. Both 2-D and 3-D materials will be used to create visual poetry from the commonplace.

Julie Steyer, a mixed media artist exploring colored pencil, watercolor, collage and acrylic, majored in art at UC Santa Cruz. Julie has taught youth and adults for 20 years and is currently exploring mixed media collage and assemblage.
